Work at places other than those mentioned may be in progress, of which it may not have been possible to give previous notice, and drivers must be on the look-out and be prepared to stop or run at reduced speed when and where hand signals may be exhibited.

In the case of items marked \dagger the Warning Board(s) will be lit by propane gas.

In the case of items marked * the Warning Boards and Indicators will be moved as the work progresses and the restriction will not operate over more than $\frac{3}{4}$ mile at one time.

In the case of items marked ‡ time has been allowed in the working timetable for these restrictions.

Temporary speed restrictions may be eased or withdrawn earlier than shown. Trainmen must, therefore, be prepared to find a higher speed (which may be the permanent speed restriction) indicated at the Warning Boards and Indicators and they must work to such speed.
