Work at places other than those mentioned may be in progress, of which it may not have been possible to give previous notice, and drivers must be on the look-out and be prepared to stop or run at reduced speed when and where hand signals may be exhibited.

In the case of items marked t the Warning Board(s) will be lit by propane gas.

In the case of items marked \* the Warning Boards and Indicators will be moved as the work progresses and the restriction will not operate over more than  $\frac{3}{4}$  mile at one time.

In the case of items marked ‡ time has been allowed in the working timetable for these restrictions.

Temporary speed restrictions may be eased or withdrawn earlier than shown. Trainmen must, therefore, be prepared to find a higher speed (which may be the permanent speed restriction) indicated at the Warning Boards and Indicators and they must work to such speed.
