Trainmen must pay particular attention to works contained in this notice and keep a good look-out for hand signals, which will be exhibited at the various localities in accordance with the Rules and Regulations. Work at places other than those mentioned may be in progress of which it may not have been possible to give previous notice, and drivers must be on the look-out and be prepared to stop or run at reduced speed when and where hand signals may be exhibited.

At the start of the speed restriction, a sign will display figures indicating the maximum permissible speed in miles per hour. A second sign will display the letter "T" to indicate that normal speed may be resumed from that point. Warning boards are not provided.

Certain signs will not be illuminated when the traction current is switched off.

# SOUTHERN REGION

Temporary speed restrictions may be eased or withdrawn earlier than shown. Trainmen must, therefore, be prepared to find a higher speed (which may be the permanent speed restriction) indicated at the warning board and indicators and they must work to such speed.

Warning boards and indicators provided unless otherwise shown.

In the case of items marked \* the warning board(s) and indicators will be moved as the work progresses.

In the case of items marked † the warning board(s) will be lit by propane gas.

The trailing crossover between the Down and Up Local lines in Selhurst station will be put out of use, the points being clipped and padlocked pending abolition.

The shunting signal Thornton Heath side of Selhurst station controlling movements from the Up Local to Down Local lines or back along Up Local line will be repositioned 219 yards nearer Thornton Heath and will in future only apply for movements from the Up Local to the Down Local lines.


