DETAILS OF WORK ALREADY CARRIED OUT

MILLBROOK

A new 3 aspect colour light Up Home signal (MB2) together with a telephone in direct communication with the signal box has been provided 224 yards further from the signal box than the semaphore signals which have been removed. The red aspect is now 16 feet above rail level.

A junction indicator working in conjunction with the signal has been provided and will be illuminated for trains proceeding to the Up Local line.

A new position light Up Freightliner Terminal Home signal has been provided to the left of the new signal.

A.W.S. equipment has been provided 200 yards before reaching the signal.


