INCLUSIVE

Trainmen must pay particular attention to works contained in this notice and keep a good look-out for hand signals, which will be exhibited at the various localities in accordance with the Rules and Regulations. Work at places other than those mentioned may be in progress of which it may not have been possible to give previous notice, and drivers must be on the look-out and be prepared to stop or run at reduced speed when and where hand signals may be exhibited.

### **TEMPORARY SPEED RESTRICTIONS**

### **LONDON TRANSPORT**

Temporary speed restrictions may be eased or withdrawn earlier than shown. At the start of the speed restriction, a sign will display figures indicating the maximum permissible speed in miles per hour. A second sign will display the letter "T" to indicate that normal speed may be resumed from that point.

Warning boards are not provided.

Certain signs will not be illuminated when the traction current is switched off.

In the case of items marked \* the warning board(s) and indicators will be moved as the work progresses.

In the case of items marked † the warning board(s) will be lit by propane gas.

### **FELTHAM EAST**

A new four lever ground frame ('B') with a telephone direct to the signal box has been provided Ashford side of the signal box. The adjacent trailing connection between the Up Main line and Up Siding is worked from the new ground frame.

The shunting signal Ashford side of the signal box, controlling movements from Up Main to Down Main or Up siding has been replaced with a position light signal and applies as hitherto.

The shunting signal Ashford side of the signal box, controlling movements along Up Siding or from Up Siding to Up Main, has been replaced with a yellow position light signal which is controlled by the new ground frame applying only from Up Siding to Up Main.

The shunting signal Ashford side of the signal box, controlling movements from Down Main to Up Main, has been abolished.

The existing Feltham East Ground frame has become ground frame 'A'.

The shunting signal Ashford side of the signal box, (controlled by Ground Frame 'A'), controlling movements from Down Main to Down Siding, has been replaced with a position light signal which is additionally controlled from the signal box and applies from Down Main to Up Main or to Down Siding.

The yellow arm signal Ashford side of the signal box, (controlled by Ground Frame 'A'). controlling movements from Down Siding to Down Main, has been replaced with a position light signal and applies as hitherto.

A new Down line 3-aspect colour light automatic signal (F.351) together with a telephone in direct communication with Ascot 'B' signal box has been provided 1962 yards on the approach side of signal (WM.499). The height of the red aspect is 12 feet above rail level.

A new 2-aspect (yellow/green) colour light automatic distant signal (F.351R) has been provided, 2,258 yards on the approach side of signal (F.351). This signal has a 3-aspect head, the lowest (red) aspect remaining temporarily out of use.

A new Up line 2-aspect (red/green) automatic signal (F.352) together with a telephone in direct communication with Ascot 'B' signal box has been provided at the Ascot end of Bracknell Up Platform. The height of the red aspect is 11 feet above rail level.

A new Up line 2-aspect (yellow/green) colour light automatic distant signal (F.352R) has been provided 2127 yards on the approach side of signal (F.352).

The distance between signal (WM.504) and signal (F.352) is 3,855 yards.

The catch points in the Up line, 700 yards before reaching signal (F.352) have been brought into use. The catch points in the Up line 1523 yards Wokingham side of the signal box, have been secured out of use pending abolition. (7)
