Work at places other than those mentioned may be in progress of which it may not have been possible to give previous notice, and drivers must be on the look-out and be prepared to stop or run at reduced speed when and where hand signals may be exhibited.





Engineer's Sidings Nos.1 and 2 and Cripple Siding — Amend heading to read:—
"Engineer's sidings Nos.1 and 2"

Delete "also the cripple siding" from the first line.

Add as new instruction:—
Maritime New Holding Siding and Cripple Siding

All movements between these sidings and the Engine Line must be attended by the Senior Railman, who will authorise the entry to either siding on receipt of permission from the terminal overseer. The terminal overseer will authorise all movements from the sidings as far as the "Stop" Board at the convergence of the New Holding Siding and Engine Line. The Senior Railman will be responsible for the operation of the Engine Line hand points and for their restoration to the normal Engine Line position after the movement has been completed and must also assist in controlling movements into the sidings.

The points to the Cripple Siding must be clipped and padlocked towards the New Holding Siding position when not being used. The padlock key must be kept in the Maritime Freightliner Traffic Office under the control of the terminal overseer. (31D)

SPEED RESTRICTIONS: TANK WAGONS ETC., 15 FT. WHEEL BASE OR LESS

The speed of certain 2-axle rail tanks with a wheel base of 15ft. or less, and PRESFLO, CEMFLO and R.I.V. types when running in the empty/discharged condition must be restricted to a maximum speed at 45 m.p.h.

T.O.P.S. train lists show the applicable speed, and every effort should be made to provide guards with a valid train list.

If no train list is available, and any doubt exists, 45m.p.h. restriction must be applied, or where a lower speed than 45 m.p.h. is in operations this must apply. (OD15/Pad 6/TV)
